



Admiral Cunningham Closure

As many of you may know there have been rumours relating to the possible closure of the Admiral Cunningham Pub for a couple of months.

It has now been confirmed that this will be the case and the owners have given a closure notice to the existing landlady, Jeanette, which states that the last day of trading will be Sunday, 21st March.

This means of course that the club now has very little time to find a new home.

Over the last 2 weeks however steps have been taken to re-locate to the Limes. The Limes committee still has to finally confirm that this can go ahead but this looks to be the likely outcome. Thanks to them for helping out at such short notice.

The 2 teams that play in the league (6 a side, Div 3) and (9 a side, Div 2) who would have normally played Home games on Wednesdays will now play these games on Tuesdays at the Limes. Please take necessary action to amend your fixture list if you play in either of these leagues or speak to AC team rep to confirm.

Other events that were organised to take place at the Admiral, usually on Saturdays will now be held at the Limes, but this still has to be confirmed to fit in with scheduled Melees/Opens organised by the Limes.

The AC Open on April 17th has been cancelled to give time for new arrangements to be made.
